Methodology


The annual survey was available to CPAC attendees from Wednesday, February 26th to Saturday, February 29th. A total of 1336 CPAC attendees participated in the survey.

Participants had the option to complete the survey through the official CPAC App on their mobile device or in person at one of the poll stations.


For security purposes, each CPAC attendee was assigned a unique, eight digit PIN code with their registration materials. To complete the survey, respondents were required to enter their PIN code as well as the surname used to register, ensuring that only CPAC registrants could participate.

Do you approve or disapprove of the job that Donald Trump is doing as President?




Since Donald Trump became President, has you and your family's quality of life...?




Since Donald Trump became President, do you feel the United States has become...?




Which of the following comes closest to your own personal opinion on President Trump's impeachment?

Which of the following comes closer to your own personal opinion on Senator Mitt Romney?






Now, which Democrat do you think is the biggest threat to President Trump winning re-election in 2020?

(Ranked Greatest to Least)





Do you approve or disapprove of the job that Bill Barr is doing as Attorney General?






Most Important Issues

(Respondents Permitted to Select Three; Ranked Greatest to Least)




Biggest Foreign Safety Threat






Do you favor or oppose “Medicare for All”?





When it comes to the issue of immigration, which priority is MOST important to you? (Ranked by Greatest to Least)




Among the following, which would you most like to see as the 28th Amendment and added to the United States Constitution?






Agree/Disagree:
